### DESCRIPTION

- 88.7 Bridge: Wall Street, Leesport  
 LANDING: RL, Leesport Canoe Launch. Ownership: Borough of Leesport. Parking: Behind Post Office, 15+. LAT 40.4456°, LONG -75.9682°  
**CAUTION:** Strong current and eddy at left side of bridge. Stay in middle of river, and immediately past the bridge, paddle RL to canoe launch
- 87.9, RR, Herbein's Lock Remnant.
- 86.7 Confluence: RL, Maiden Creek
- 85.2 Peacock's Bridge, Railroad. Stone arch bridge with 12 ft. diameter "eyes" or circles between arches.
- 82.0 LANDING: RR, Epler's Landing boat ramp. Parking: 5+. LAT 40.3966°, LONG -75.9737°
- 81.5 LANDING: RL, Felix Dam Park. Ownership: Muhlenberg Township. Parking: 10+. LAT 40.3906°, LONG -75.9667°
- Follow path up river to remains of Felix's Lock (Lock #42), also called Rothermel or Ritz.
